



Global warming predictions

- The weather will get warmer by 2-5 degrees in the next 100 years.
- The sea level will rise by one metre before the end of this century.
- Experts think that by 2080, 25% of coastal towns around the world will be flooded.
- Food will be more expensive and there will be less food for people in poor countries.
- Global warming doesn't mean that we will have nice weather. Europe may have too much rain in some places, too little in others.
